Implementation blueprinting and control	Scope validation, process mapping, systems integration, owners, decision points, KPIs, exception paths and go-live planning before execution begins.

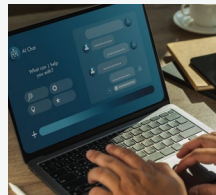
